# **Teaching English Grammar** (**Grammar Advisor**)

#### **Course Overview**

The Bridge Education Group, Inc Online Specialized Certificate: Teaching English Grammar course, also known as Grammar Advisor, is a 40-hour online certificate program. As it is a self-study course, it can be done at the trainee's own pace. The Grammar Advisor Course is a grammar reference designed specifically for teachers of English as a Foreign Language and English as a Second Language. System Requirements: This course is accessed and delivered via the Internet. Trainees are responsible for obtaining the necessary equipment, Internet connection, and Internet browser to access the course.

Materials Required: The program is self-contained; no additional text or reference is required. All materials required are provided in the platform. Examinations are taken and assessed in the platform. Access to an Internet connection with sufficient speed to view videos is required.

Tutor Information: Trainees contact the grammar advisor (a tutor) via the messaging function within the course for any questions on course content or additional support.



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Schedule of Topics: Enrollment in the course is open. Trainees can begin at any date and proceed at their own pace. There is a one-year maximum time limit for completion. In each module, trainees must complete a quiz before progressing to the next section.
